

ST. ALBERT\MORINVILLE KUB KAR RALLY 2008

Official Kub Kar Race Rules

1. All Cubs, leaders and volunteers will conduct themselves in the spirit of Scouting, good conduct and good sportsmanship throughout the Rally.
2. Each participating youth and leader is expected to bring a food bank donation in the equivalent amount as the waived registration fee (\$6) for presentation to the Breakfast Optimist Club of St. Albert and then the St. Albert Food Bank. The Breakfast Optimist Club is the official Sponsor of the Kub Kar Rally.
3. Kub Kars must be made in the 2007-2008 Scouting year. Pre-made pinewood cars are allowed in the Rally, but ineligible for the Kub's Choice category.
4. Youth displaying inappropriate and/or disruptive behavior will be asked to step aside from the activities, and a discussion will be held with their Pack Leader. If such behavior continues, the youth's parents will be contacted and the youth may be asked to leave the Rally.
5. The Race Judge will be consulted on any and all issues of contention or concern to rule on the matter, and **the Race Judge's decision is final.** No arguments.
6. All Kub Kar Rally participants must be registered to participate, **in uniform**, and wear their name tags at all times.
7. Each Scouting Group is responsible for having their youth and adult physical fitness forms, parent contact information, and permission sheets (if required by your group), on hand at the Mall in case of injuries or other instances.
8. This is a no-trace event and, therefore, each person is responsible for cleaning up after themselves and ensuring their belongings are stored in a safe and appropriate location.
9. **THE PIT STOP** will be open at registration for the following type of repairs/ modifications: (No modifications are allowed after the racing begins.)
 - Reduction of Kub Kar weight to the allowable weight of 142g.
 - Replacement or fixing of wheels that may become dislodged/loose as a result of accidents.
 - The Pit Stop will **NOT** be used for the addition of weights.
 - The Pit Stop will be closed before racing begins except for emergency repairs (Only Leaders are to use the facility)
10. No oil or wet lubricants permitted. Lubrication is not permitted between races.

Kub Kar Race Operations

(also see Rally Race Schedule)

1. Upon arriving at Grandin Mall, a representative from each Scouting Group will proceed to the registration desk with their youth to;
 - a. Confirm youth and adults in attendance from master list;
 - b. Receive a name tag for each participant and ribbon for the youth;
 - c. Weigh Kub Kars and receive a starting station location number; and,
 - d. Groups will receive an envelope upon registration containing their registered youth Kub Kar badges, copy of rules, name tags, etc.
2. Upon registering, each youth in a Pack will be assigned a number to designate their "Starting Station" to begin the station rotation. Youth will be assigned a number from 1-6 as they are registered to ensure youth are partnered with youth from other participating Cub Packs.
3. Kub Kar Rally will begin with a Grand Howl, singing of O Canada, and brief explanation of rules and expected conduct.
4. Youth, leaders, Official Recorders, will then proceed to their assigned "Starting Stations" to begin the Rally. The rotation shall be in accordance with the Rally schedule and based on the next highest number (i.e. #1 will proceed to Station #2, #2 to Station #3, etc. Station #6 groups will rotate to Station #1).
5. Winners of the 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place Kub Kar Rally 2008 trophies will be tabulated from the top three Cubs scoring the lowest points overall in a calculation of all Station activities.
6. At each activity Station, Cubs in each group will be awarded points for their 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finish (ie. 1 point for 1st place, 2 points for 2nd, and 3 points for 3rd). These points will be used in the tabulation of the overall winners. Like in golf, the lowest three scores win.
7. In case of a tie, the winners will be determined by way of a timed race-off on Station #6. Fastest time wins 1st, the next Kar 2nd, etc.

8. A Group Leader or volunteer, designated as the Official Recorder, will be assigned to a station group of up to 15 Cubs, and will accompany that group around the circuit of events to record the various station winners in their assigned group.
9. At each station, a Kub Kar ribbon will be awarded to 1st place winners, 2nd and 3rd place finishers for that station. The ribbons will be presented at the end of each Station activity and can be given to the Official Recorder to give to the Cubs later should there not be enough time for a presentation.
10. While at Station #3 (Snack Station), Cubs will choose the Kub's Choice kar from their group to go into the run-off for the overall Kub's Choice trophy later.
11. The Official Recorder will monitor the sportsmanship and behavior of youth in their group at each station and during the Rally to determine nominees for the Spirit of Baden-Powell Award.
12. Each Cub is expected to bring along a bag lunch and drink for the Lunch Break. There is a snack stand on the premises (hot dogs, pop, etc.), and youth wishing to purchase their lunch will need to bring their own money. Potential line-ups at the snack stand delaying youth in getting back to their activities by 12:15 pm should be taken into consideration.
13. Groups with youth who cannot be in pictures or possibly filmed for television coverage are to inform Rally organizers at time of registration.
14. A Buffalo Plains Area Kub Kar Rally crest will be provided to all registered persons (youth and leaders).
15. Each group is responsible for bringing and/or conducting activities to entertain youth during down times, such as between registration time and the actual start of the opening ceremonies.
16. Any questions or concerns are to be directed to the Race Judge.

Kub Kar Race Day Registration Procedures

All Kars must be inspected by the race committee at registration time to make sure that it conforms with this year's regulations before being allowed to race. **The race judge's decision is final.**

A. The Registration process works like this:

A Leader from the Pack must be present during registration of their Pack.

If the Kar meets the requirements then it is registered and given a number with the starting Station location.

If it does not meet the requirements then the youth, with help from their leader or parent, will have to make modifications and go through the entire registration process again.

There will be one scale designated as the "official" scale, weight shown on this scale will be the Official weight and will NOT be open to debate.

B. All Kars must have a driver at all times during the racing

Drivers are responsible for their own kars between and during station activities.

C. Each Kar is to have the following information written on the bottom:

Cubs Name, Group Number and Year Kub Kar was made
