All activities build toward a full-day quest that will challenge the physical stamina, mental agility, and creativity of your entire six-member team

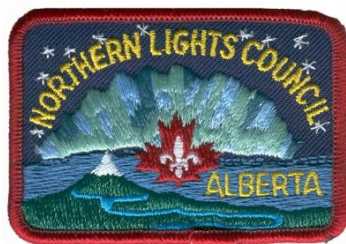
